

MESSy Software Licence Agreement

(Version of 11.12.2013)

This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which the software known as MESSy will be licenced by the MESSy Consortium to the Licensee, and by which Derivative Works (as hereafter defined) of MESSy will be licenced by the Licensee to the MESSy Consortium.

Definitions

Licensee is you, only if you agree to be bound by the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

MESSy shall mean the "Modular Earth Submodel System" as originally created by the members of the MESSy Consortium, and any Derivative Works thereof as created by either the MESSy Consortium or Licensee, but shall include only those Derivative Works the MESSy Consortium has approved for inclusion into, and the MESSy Consortium has integrated into MESSy.

Standard Version shall mean MESSy, as originally created and successively maintained by the MESSy Consortium.

Derivative Work(s) shall mean any revision, enhancement, modification, translation, abridgement, condensation or expansion created by Licensee or the MESSy Consortium that is based upon the Software or a portion thereof that would be a copyright infringement, if prepared without the authorization of the copyright owners of the Software or portion thereof.

Software shall mean MESSy and the Derivative Works created by Licensee and the collection of files distributed with MESSy, and the collection of files created through textual modifications.

Copyright Holder is whoever is named in the copyright or copyrights for the Derivative Works.

Freely Available means that no fee is charged for the item itself, though there may be fees involved in handling the item. It does not mean that recipients of the item may redistribute it under the same conditions that they received it.

Reasonable copying fee is whatever you can justify on the basis of media cost, duplication charges, time of people involved.

Conditions

1. The MESSy Consortium maintains all rights, title and interest in and to MESSy, including all applicable copyrights, trade secrets, patents and other intellectual rights therein. Licensee hereby grants to the MESSy Consortium all right, title and interest into the compilation of MESSy. Licensee shall own all rights, title and interest into the Derivative Works created by Licensee (subject to the compilation ownership by the MESSy Consortium).
2. The MESSy Consortium hereby grants to Licensee a royalty free right and licence to use, copy and make Derivative Works of MESSy.
3. Licensee hereby grants to the MESSy Consortium a royalty free, worldwide right and licence to use, copy, distribute and make Derivative Works of Derivative Works created by Licensee and sublicensing rights of any of the foregoing.

4. Licensee's right to create Derivative Works in the Software is subject to Licensee agreement to insert a prominent notice in each changed file stating how and when you changed that file, and provided that you do at least ONE of the following:
 - a) make your modifications Freely Available to the MESSy Consortium, such as by posting said modifications to the MESSy Consortium Steering Group or an equivalent medium and by providing your modifications to the Copyright Holder after evaluation and scientific publication. The developments are requested to follow the MESSy coding standards and require a reasonable documentation.
 - b) make other distribution arrangements with the Copyright Holder.
5. Licensee may distribute the programs of the Derivative Works under no circumstances, as long as no other distribution arrangements are made with the MESSy Consortium.
6. Licensee may charge any fee you choose for support of this Software. You may not charge a fee for this Software itself.
7. The data and images produced as output from the Software does automatically fall under the copyright of this Software, but belong to whomever generated them. For any kind of input data the corresponding data protocols have to be followed by the Licensee.
8. The MESSy Consortium makes no representation about the suitability of MESSy for any purposes. The MESSy Consortium shall have no duty or requirement to include any Derivative Works into MESSy. MESSy is supported by the MESSy Consortium only via guidelines and informations which can be obtained from the MESSy Consortium Website, the Community Wiki, and the MESSy Community Mailing List. The MESSy Consortium does not guarantee any support even on the above mentioned platforms. Furthermore, support is restricted to the standard versions only. Any Derivative Work beyond the latest release is not supported by the MESSy Consortium.
9. Each party hereto represents and warrants that they have the full unrestricted right to grant all rights and licences granted to the other party herein.

IN NO EVENT SHALL COPYRIGHT HOLDER BE LIABLE FOR ANY DIRECT, SPECIAL, INDIRECT OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES WHATSOEVER RESULTING FROM LOSS OF USE OF DATA OR PROFITS, WHETHER IN AN ACTION OF CONTRACT, NEGLIGENCE OR OTHER TORTIOUS CONDUCT, ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE USE OR PERFORMANCE OF THIS PACKAGE.
